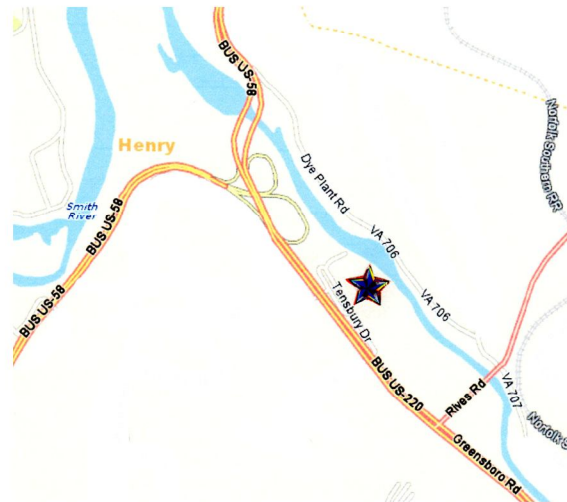
Welcome!
